OREGON COAST

The Oregon Chautauqua is held at Camp Westwind - a beautiful, secluded, north Pacific Coast retreat center. Westwind is located near the majestic Cascade Head, north of Lincoln City, Oregon.

Westwind lies in the temperate zone straddling the 45th parallel, exactly half way between the North Pole and the Equator. Its 508 acres are amongst the last tracts of wild Oregon coast lands remaining.

- * Two miles of marine coastline with sand beaches and a rocky headlands.
- * Fertile estuarine habitat for fish spawning migrations centered around the Salmon River.
- * Upland fresh water lake and mature coastal forests, great for hiking.


A WEEK IN SEPTEMBER

CAMP WESTWIND

The event is held in a residential camp setting. Accommodations include a large beachfront lodge with a commercial kitchen and smaller rustic cabins with bunk beds.

Families bring their own bedding.

Due to the size of the event, families usually need to share cabins.

Tenting is an option, if you prefer privacy. There are flush toilets and hot showers located near the lodge.



COMMUNITY

Community is at the heart of the Chautauqua experience.

To keep the cost to a minimum and to contribute to the cooperative spirit, everyone age 9 and older takes turns cooking and cleaning up after meals. We also need your help on the final day clean-up.

We serve yummy vegetarian meals for dinner and breakfast. Families bring their own lunches and snacks.
